

HRCI's Exam Development Panels contribute to item writing, item review and forms review for our certification exams.

Time Commitment

To become a volunteer on one of our exam development panels, HRCI exam development activities will be conducted either virtually or in-person depending on the exam and panel needs (usually 2-4 days, occurring over a weekend for live meetings; virtual meetings are conducted based on availability and needs to the program with independent work assigned). Members will be expected to complete pre-meeting work according to established deadlines and assignments.

Eligibility

In order to be a volunteer on one or our Exam Development Panels, you must meet the specific criteria of the panel, listed below.

Selection Criteria

We choose a diversity of panel members so that the panels contain a range of experience, gender, culture, race, and geography.

Training

We train selected volunteers in the entire exam development process to create and evaluate high-quality items.

Recertification Credit

Individuals who are selected as volunteers and who participate in either live or virtual meetings will be eligible to earn recertification credit.
